Attention: All Dog Owners

We have received numerous complaints about dog feces in yards. It is unfair to the home owner and to the maintenance crew that have to clean up after your dog/s.

Please be responsible for your dogs: keep them in your yard, have your pet on a leash when walking, and clean up after them. Do not let your dog run loose in the community!

Parasites and bacteria from dog feces can remain in the soil for years. By not picking up after your dog, you're putting other people's pets at risk of exposure to harmful bacteria. Children who play outside and gardeners are especially at risk for contamination. This is harmful bacteria also affects water quality.
