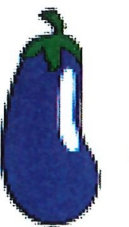

Stable Harvest Farm Vegetable Donation



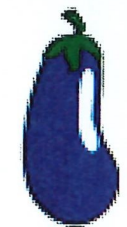
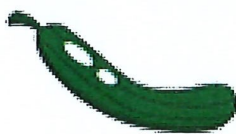
