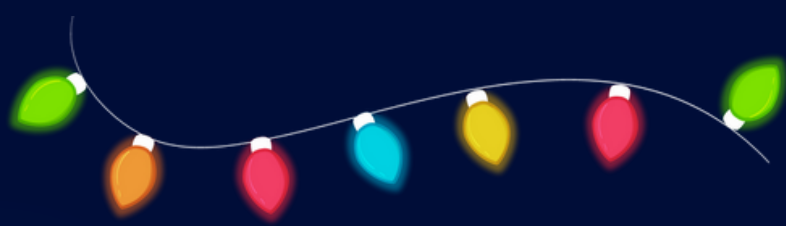

Notice is hereby given that a meeting of the electors of the Katzie First Nation will be held at the Katzie Health and Community Centre (IR #1) on Thursday, January 29, 2026, beginning at 7:00 pm, for the purpose of nominating candidates for the positions of Chief and Councillors on the Band Council of the Katzie First Nation for the term beginning April 1, 2026 and ending March 31, 2028. ## Summary # 3 2019 Katzie Soil and Fill Law

During the Katzie First Nation Land Code and Laws Community Engagement Sessions held in late 2024 and early 2025 at each of the Katzie Communities, one of the requests received during the sessions from the Katzie Member participants was for the Lands Department to summarize the 2016 Katzie First Nation Land Code and the existing Katzie First Nation Laws.

On November 25, 2025, the Lands Department issued Summary # 2, the 2016 Katzie First Nation Subdivision, Development & Servicing Law.

This week, the Lands Department is happy to provide you with a summary of the 2019 Katzie Soil and Fill Law.



## Summary # 3 2019 Katzie Soil and Fill Law

**Purpose:** To regulate the deposit, removal, and management of soil and fill materials within Katzie lands in a way that:

- Ensures all soil and fill activities are conducted in a manner that protects the environment and community health.
- Preserves water quality, fish habitat, and culturally significant areas from contamination or degradation.
- Provides clear procedures for obtaining permits and approvals before any soil deposit or removal.
- Supports sustainable development and responsible land use on Katzie Lands.

### Key Components

#### 1. Permit Requirements

- Any individual or organization seeking to deposit, remove, or move soil or fill within Katzie First Nation lands must apply for a permit.
- A permit is not required for a Katzie Member completing moderate residential property improvements such as landscaping, gardening plots, or driveway work. If the soil or gravel amount exceeds 10 cubic meters (half-size dump truck) in a year, a minor permit from the Lands Department is required.
- The application process requires details about the source and nature of materials, intended location, volume, and potential environmental impacts. Permits may include conditions to reduce risks to land, water, and cultural resources.



## Summary # 3 2019 Katzie Soil and Fill Law

### 2. Prohibited Activities

- Depositing or removing soil or fill without authorization.
- Activities that may cause pollution, erosion, or harm to sensitive ecosystems or heritage sites.
- Failing to comply with permit conditions or monitoring requirements.

### 3. Inspection and Enforcement

Designated Katzie First Nation officials may inspect sites, enforce compliance, and issue stop-work orders if needed. Penalties for non-compliance may include fines, restoration orders, or legal action.

### 4. Environmental and Cultural Protection

Special provisions protect fish-bearing streams, wetlands, archaeological sites, and culturally significant areas. All activities must be planned to avoid or mitigate negative impacts on these resources.

### Conclusion

The Katzie First Nation Soil and Fill Law reflects the community's commitment to environmental stewardship, cultural preservation, and sustainable land management. By regulating soil and fill activities, the law helps safeguard Katzie territory for present and future generations.

## Upcoming Work at cx<sup>w</sup>ít (Hammond Mill)

Hammond Mill closed in 2017, and Conwest Development purchased the mill from Interfor to build industrial warehouses. The mill is part of cx<sup>w</sup>ít (Katzie Village), and within the mill property is the resting place of our Ancestors.

Katzie continues to work with Conwest, Province of BC, Vancouver Fraser Port Authority and Maple Ridge to develop a plan for the mill site, that respects Katzie responsibility to protect our Ancestors, and build respect, honor and understanding for cx<sup>w</sup>ít and Katzie people, past, present, and future. We are making good progress on this and are working towards an outcome where Katzie will be able to protect our Ancestors and receive direct benefits from the future development of the site.

Conwest has asked to work with Katzie on early development work placing piles of pre-load fill material at five locations within the property (locations shown on next page). This work will involve the removal of asphalt, foundations, and pilings within the five sites, and the placement of clean fill piles. The piles will be 30m x 30m square, which is about 5.3m high. The purpose is to see if further measures, aside from preloading the land, are needed to meet engineering requirements to hold future buildings.

Our Guardians will monitor this work and ensure our Ancestors and their sacred belongings are cared for in keeping with our laws, protocols, and hereditary responsibilities. We will host ceremonial work before ground disturbances begins, and Guardians will be monitoring the work to ensure that Ancestral belongings and our Ancestors are protected and cared for appropriately if disturbed during the work.

There will be a public notification for this work from Conwest to Port Hammond Residents, a sign posted at the site, and newspaper notifications in October. We wanted to take this opportunity to ensure that Katzie people are aware of this work before public notices are issued. Following the public notification period this fall, we will work with Conwest on the timing of the work.
