

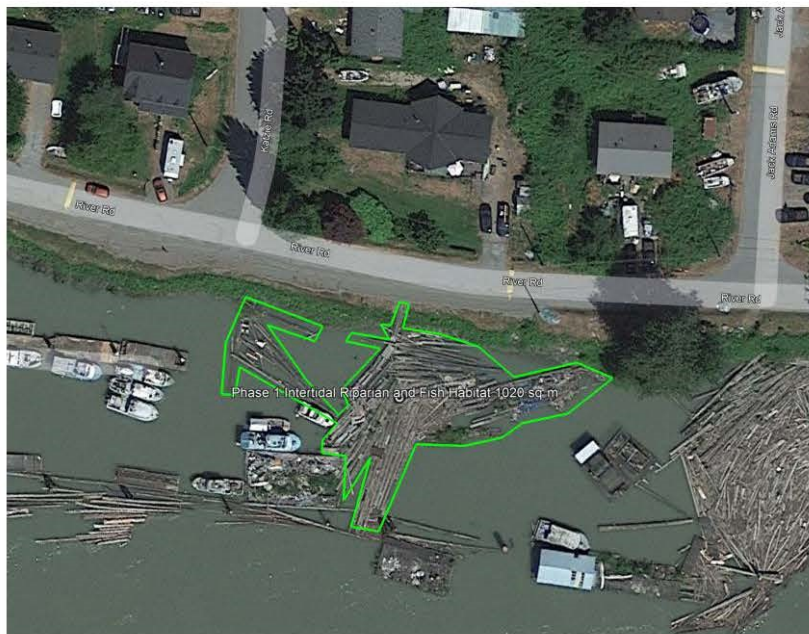
IR#1 WHARF CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

- Provide as much detailed information such as residence & street address, persons name, license plate, photo etc. in your report.

*Note: You could receive a cash reward of up to **\$ 2000** upon an arrest and charge.*

KFN Animal Control Law is for the Protection of People- Pets - Property.

Dogs must not be left to roam “At Large”

- All dogs must be confined within the boundaries of the dog owner’s property.
- When an owner of a dog is walking their dog on public property the dog must be kept on a leash. Use a leash no longer than 2 meters long.



**Your Dog...
Your Responsibility!**

Control Barking


- Dogs bark when bored, lonely or to alert their owners. Please ensure your dog is a good neighbor.
- Resolve barking by training, socializing, exercising and providing family interaction.

Should you need to file a complaint about a dog as result of non-compliance to the KFN Animal Control Law , have a question or would like a copy of the KFN Animal Control Law please contact the Land Steward, @ landsteward@katzie.ca cc: landsadmin@katzie.ca or contact the Lands Steward by phone at 604-465-8921 ext. 418.

Note: No person shall own or keep any Dog that is over the age of six (6) months within the Nation's Land unless that dog is spayed or neutered by a Veterinarian (as per section 7.3 KFN Animal Control Law).

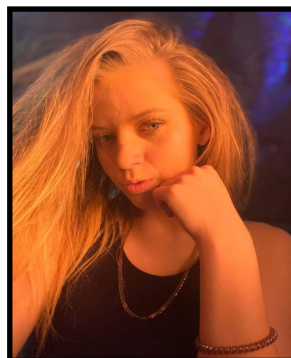
