## **NOTICE OF PROPOSED REVENUE LAWS**

Katzie Chief and Council this week proposed the enactment of the Katzie First Nation Property Assessment Law, 2023 and the Katzie First Nation Property Taxation Law, 2023.

As per the last General Band Meeting report, these laws will allow collection of property and development taxes on properties and businesses that reside on Katzie land from third parties. KFN members will be exempt from paying these taxes.

## Community Update

The Katzie First Nation has successfully completed its 2022-2027 Strategic Plan, which was approved by Chief and Council on November 17, 2022.

The plan establishes the guiding vision for our community, the goals we have identified to move us towards achieving our vision, and the objectives we need to fulfill to support these goals. A strategic plan is similar to a road map. Its purpose is to help us to get to where we want to go. For Katzie, the Strategic Plan is meant to direct the actions of staff and leadership and inform work plans undertaken by departments. It sets out the path to our destination – our vision for the future.

The objectives and goals of the 2022-2027 Strategic Plan build on the previous 2014-2019 Strategic Plan. The 2022-2027 Strategic Plan was developed with input from Council, community members, and staff. The process affirmed our collective vision, mission, and values. It also established 13 priority goals and objectives for achieving those goals. Finally, it contains feedback from community members and staff as well as Council's implementation goals.

## Survey Funding Available

We have limited funding available for land surveys, if you are a Member living on reserve . These funds can be used to subdivide property or survey new boundaries.

Please note that you need approval under the KFN Subdivision Development Servicing Law (2019) to subdivide a property or create new lots. This process was designed to ensure that

1. No neighbouring property gets taken in by mistake
2. Ensure that access to roads and other services is taken into consideration
3. The survey is registered properly so that it is legal and can be transferred, leased, willed, etc.

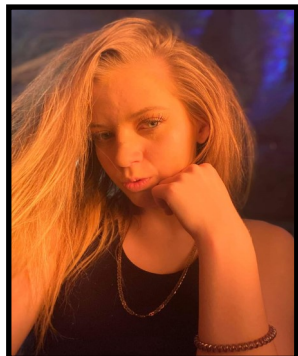

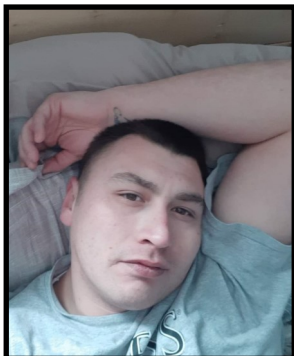
