

Upcoming Work at cx^wít (Hammond Mill)

Hammond Mill closed in 2017, and Conwest Development purchased the mill from Interfor to build industrial warehouses. The mill is part of cx^wít (Katzie Village), and within the mill property is the resting place of our Ancestors.

Katzie continues to work with Conwest, Province of BC, Vancouver Fraser Port Authority and Maple Ridge to develop a plan for the mill site, that respects Katzie responsibility to protect our Ancestors, and build respect, honor and understanding for cx^wít and Katzie people, past, present, and future. We are making good progress on this and are working towards an outcome where Katzie will be able to protect our Ancestors and receive direct benefits from the future development of the site.

Conwest has asked to work with Katzie on early development work placing piles of pre-load fill material at five locations within the property (locations shown on next page). This work will involve the removal of asphalt, foundations, and pilings within the five sites, and the placement of clean fill piles. The piles will be 30m x 30m square, which is about 5.3m high. The purpose is to see if further measures, aside from preloading the land, are needed to meet engineering requirements to hold future buildings.

Our Guardians will monitor this work and ensure our Ancestors and their sacred belongings are cared for in keeping with our laws, protocols, and hereditary responsibilities. We will host ceremonial work before ground disturbances begins, and Guardians will be monitoring the work to ensure that Ancestral belongings and our Ancestors are protected and cared for appropriately if disturbed during the work.

There will be a public notification for this work from Conwest to Port Hammond Residents, a sign posted at the site, and newspaper notifications in October. We wanted to take this opportunity to ensure that Katzie people are aware of this work before public notices are issued. Following the public notification period this fall, we will work with Conwest on the timing of the work.

No other work is being considered at this time, though as we move forward in our discussions, further work will take place, with continued oversight and support from Katzie. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact Roma Leon at Roma@katzie.ca or 778 227 2751.
