Notice of Ratification Vote



DATE: October 5, 2023

TO: THE MEMBERS OF KATZIE FIRST NATION (THE "FIRST NATION")

TAKE NOTICE that a Ratification Vote of the Voters of the First Nation pursuant to the Voting Guidelines of the Katzie I.R. No. 1 and I.R. No. 3 (Dykes and Roads) Specific Claim Settlement Agreement (the "Voting Guidelines") will be held on November 12, 2023 to determine if the Voters of the First Nation approve and assent to the Katzie I.R. No. 1 and I.R. No. 3 (Dykes and Roads) Specific Claim Settlement Agreement (the "Settlement Agreement") between Canada and the First Nation summarized in this Notice and outlined in the Information Document attached as Appendix "A". The Settlement Agreement is also attached as Appendix "B".

The following Ballot Question will be asked of the Voters of the First Nation by secret ballot, as set out in Schedule "2" to the Settlement Agreement:

As a Voter of the First Nation, do you:

- a) agree to all of the terms and conditions of the Katzie I.R. No. 1 and I.R. No. 3 (Dykes and Roads) Specific Claim Settlement Agreement initialled by the negotiators for the First Nation and Canada, which settles the Katzie I.R. No. 1 and I.R. No. 3 (Dykes and Roads) Specific Claim and releases Canada from the claims set forth in the Katzie I.R. No. 1 and I.R. No. 3 (Dykes and Roads) Specific Claim;

AND

- b) authorize the Council of the First Nation to sign all documents and do everything necessary to give effect to the Katzie I.R. No. 1 and I.R. No. 3 (Dykes and Roads) Specific Claim Settlement Agreement?

Eligible Voters are Katzie members who are 18 years of age or older on voting day and are not disqualified from voting at band elections.

You may vote in person on either of the Voting Days or by Mail-in Ballot, as provided for under the Voting Guidelines.

Included with this Notice of Ratification Vote are copies of the Settlement Agreement (without the Voting Guidelines and forms), and such other information as the Council determines.

AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE that a Voters List is posted with this Notice of Ratification Vote. Sections 5.2 and 5.3 of the Voting Guidelines provide:

5.2 A Member may apply to the Ratification Officer before the Voting Day to have the Voters List revised if such Member believes that:

5.2.1 the name of a Voter has been omitted from the Voters List; or

5.2.2 the name of a Voter is incorrectly set out or should not be included on the Voters List.

5.3 A Member of the First Nation may, up to and including the Voting Day, apply to the Ratification Officer to have their name added to the Voters List if that Member provides:

5.3.1 proof of eligibility to vote by completing the Declaration of Membership and Eligibility to Vote Form substantially in the form of Appendix "D". This proof shall include documentation that verifies that the Voter's name is recorded on the Band List, and that

the Voter is at least eighteen years old on the date of the Ratification Vote and not disqualified from voting at band elections.

- 5.3.2 Upon receipt and confirmation of the information in the Declaration of Membership and Eligibility to Vote form, the Ratification Officer will revise the Voters List.

KATZIE AFFORDABLE HOUSING PROJECT IS SET TO BEGIN!

Chief and Council are pleased and excited to announce that construction is scheduled to commence soon on our new Katzie Affordable Housing Project on IR#1.

As you may recall from previous communications shared at General Band meetings, this is an important new project that will bring significant benefits to our membership.

It will include construction of three new housing complex's:

- **Building 1:** Youth program to house 10 at risk youth with 24/7 support, Elder's Lounge and Administration office spaces.
- **Building 2:** 3 story residential building including 16 self-contained suites with 24/7 support and,
- **Building 3:** 3 story residential building, including 14 self-contained suites for individuals and families.

Housing Project construction site address locations:

- 19676, 19679 and 19696 Salish Rd. Pitt Meadows.
- Construction is scheduled to begin on **Tuesday, October 4th, 2023**, including installation of underground municipal services.

The contractor for this project is **Mierau Contractors Ltd.**, who we are working closely with to ensure that any impacts to members are kept to a minimum. A map of the construction area is attached which also identifies the construction schedule.

We, kindly ask the following of community members during construction:

- To refrain from driving and walking on Salish Rd. near construction sites and to use alternate routes for safety reasons.

Only members who reside in the direct area will be able to access Salish Rd. during construction to get to and from their homes.
