Reminder: Dry Firewood available for Katzie Households - Firewood Program Sign-up - Expiring Soon

There is still time to sign-up for firewood under one of the following Options:

- **Option 1 – Elders and Accessibility**

- Contact Roma to sign-up.
- Roma will confirm your cut firewood delivery.
- Once confirmed, Bill Miller, Public Works and Maintenance Supervisor will then reach out to you to arrange for cut wood to be delivered to you.

- **Option 2 - For all others**

- contact Roma to sign-up.
- Roma will confirm your uncut firewood pickup.
- Once confirmed, Bill Miller, Public Works and Maintenance Supervisor will then reach out to you to arrange for blocks of wood to be available for pick-up by you on IR1.
- Members will be responsible for transporting the wood to their homes.
- Please note: Katzie is unable to provide cutting for this wood.

This will be the only opportunity for dry firewood this year and the ability to sign-up is expiring soon. We encourage Elders and/or members with barriers that will be needing firewood this winter to sign-up.
