



## Katzie Affordable Housing Project Update November 18th, 2022

After years of planning and negotiations with BC Housing, work has begun on the KFN *Affordable Housing Project* on Katzie 1. We are honoured to have been chosen as a successful proponent for our project vision. This is a very important project for Katzie as it will result in much need supportive housing for the community and allow some Katzie Members to finally come home.

These buildings will help better support youth, elders, and those at risk of homelessness.

On-site staff will provide support services to residents, including life skills and employment training, as well as referrals to health care and other services. Residents will also soon have access to community and culturally appropriate programming through the Katzie First Nation's existing health centre.

This project will result in 40 new affordable housing units for KFN Members: Building 1 (at 19696 Salish Rd) will have 10 units, specifically for youth aging out of MCFD care and or at risk of homelessness; Building 2 (19676 Salish Rd) will have 16 units and serve as transitional housing; and Building 3 (19679 Salish Rd) will have 14 units and will serve as independent affordable housing.

Here are some upcoming milestones:

- Currently the sites are being preloaded, work is expected to be completed in the next couple of weeks.
- Construction will start approximately 6 months after the preload is complete.
