This junior role is an excellent opportunity for individuals with great dexterity and willingness to learn.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Small plumbing repairs, such as repairing clogged or leaking sinks, toilets & drains.
- Small electrical repairs, such as replacing receptacles, switches & fixtures.
- Basic building repairs and maintenance, such as repairing gutters, siding, windows.
- Landscaping duties such as cutting grass, weed eating, water plants, snow removal, cleaning outdoor areas.
- Perform routine preventative maintenance of tools & equipment.
- Moving & assembling furniture and special events equipment.
- Small water system repairs & maintenance, such as bleeding & maintaining hydrants.
- Small sewer systems repairs & maintenance, including lift station maintenance.
- Minor maintenance of roads, bridges, culverts & parking lots.

QUALIFICATIONS AND SKILLS

- Experience in similar position an asset but on the job training is available.
- Ability to follow direction/instruction to execute tasks with minimal supervision.
- Demonstrated experience in the use of hand & power tools.
- Understanding of basic safety concepts and willingness to work withing required safety requirements.
- Interest in the maintenance and repairs of small power tools (e.g. pumps, power washers, mowers, weed whackers, etc.)
- Willing to work in all weather and on-call, including weekends, evenings & emergencies.



- Knowledge of Small Water Systems or willingness to complete training
- Good knowledge of First Nations communities & culture
