The Katzie First Nation Public Works team, works closely in the community to complete repairs to housing and yard maintenance as required by Katzie members. The General Labourer strives to execute the work set out by the Maintenance Operations Supervisor. In addition to completing maintenance tasks, this role is responsible for ensuring that work is performed safely.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Work alongside the Public Works crew.
- Ensure a safe work environment for the Public Works team.
- Plan and lay basic repair work.
- Perform basic plumbing, electrical and wood framing repairs.
- Perform minor roof repairs.
- Perform routine preventative maintenance on tools and equipment.
- Use of common hand and power tools to make necessary repairs.
- Troubleshoot for structural water leaks.
- Troubleshoot building envelope leaks, siding, weather-stripping and windows. (Regarding heat loss).
- Determine types and quantities of materials required for repair work.
- Provide groundkeeping services such as landscaping maintenance, snow removal and safety salt placement where required around KFN public buildings.
- Recognize and communicate with the Supervisor on any priority projects or problems.

KNOWLEDGE AND SKILLS

- Ability to work independently, prioritize, plan, and multitask with urgency.
- Experience in general construction or skilled trade.
- General working knowledge of common hand and power tools.
- Knowledge of Health and safety possibilities and preventive measures.
- Excellent interpersonal and robust customer-oriented skills
- Must be able to read, understand and apply information obtained in job specifications.
- Ability to exercise sound judgment when carrying out duties and to maintain good working relationships with the public and fellow employees.
- High energy with a friendly, positive work demeanour.
- Values providing and receiving feedback and constructive criticism.
- WHMIS Certification is an asset
- Able to physically perform the position's duties, including working from heights, lifting, and carrying up to 100 lbs.
