Firewood Available



Firewood available for Katzie Households

Firewood has become available through K & K Forestry, Katzie and Kwantlan's Forestry permit area in Blue Mountain and Malcolm Knapp Research Forest. We have put together a few options as to how Katzie members can acquire firewood for the personal use of heating their homes or green alder for smoking salmon.

- 1) K & K Forestry can have wood delivered to a central location on Katzie 1 and KFN will arrange for the wood to be cut and delivered to the homes of Elders and/or members with barriers.
- 2) We can arrange for members to have access to Blue Mountain and cut and transport their own wood.
- 3) K & K Forestry can deliver the wood to a central location on Katzie 1 for Katzie members to cut and be responsible for transporting to their own homes.
- 4) Malcolm Knapp can arrange to have 10ft. sections of alder logs delivered for the use of smoking salmon. We will need to ensure people have a safe space for delivery.

The Territorial Guardianship and Referrals Department works closely with development in Katzie territory and through this work the department can request that wood be provided to Katzie if land clearing is planned and community has need and we will continue to update community as opportunity comes up.




