### Katzie Cemetery Parking Update

As many in the community are aware, the City of Maple Ridge has been undertaking road upgrades to 203<sup>rd</sup> Ave. outside of Katzie Cemetery, which has resulted in the storage of large bins of soil in the area used for Katzie Cemetery parking.

We have heard the concern and challenges this has caused, and we are very sorry for those that have been impacted by this. We expect the storage bins of soil to be removed from the Cemetery parking in the coming week or two, and we will update community when we have a confirmed timeline for this.

The soil in these bins came from disturbed areas within the road right-ofway where lithic artifacts were discovered by KDLP. The soil is also contaminated with road salt and can not be put back into the road right-ofway because of this. Moving these soils requires permission from the Province, and we have been working through this with the City and KDLP. We have also been working with the City to build a relationship and consultation agreements for future works to ensure that Katzie is adequately consulted, and these types of challenges can be avoided in future.


