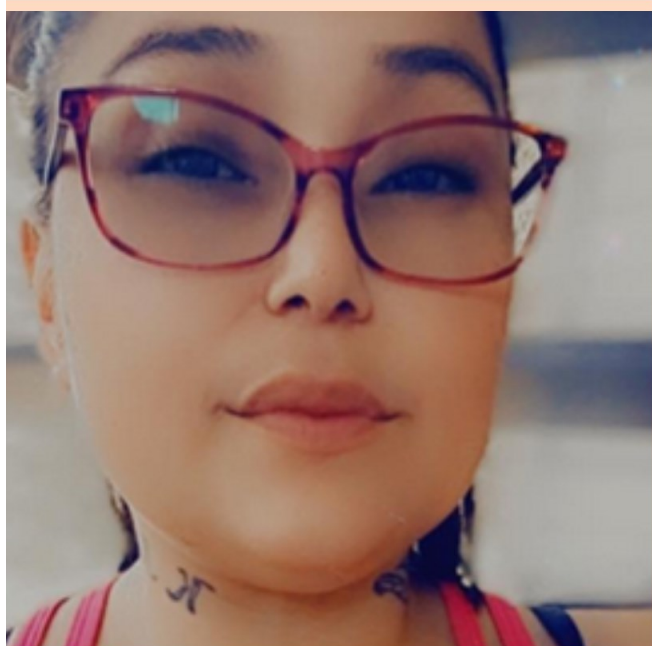

I am a mother of 3 and a grandmother to 5 and a member of the Semath First Nation where I raised my family and became an active member of the Semath longhouse community. I had the great privilege to learn from my Silver family how to hunt, fish, trap and prepare hides (skin) starting at the age of 16. I was also taught by my Auntie(s) to knit Coast Salish sweaters at the age of 19 and have been knitting ever since. My stress release had always been gardening and running until hip replacements put an end to my passion so I took up racing on sail boats which brought me to my move to White Rock in 2006. I was always led to believe that golfing was left for when you are old so sadly that is now how I enjoy spending my leisure time (and I have discovered that young people also enjoy the sport 😊).

My career began as an Education Coordinator for Semath First Nation in 1988 and in 2000 I moved to Mamele'awt Qweesome Housing Society where I started as their Headstart Coordinator. I then transitioned to Director of Programs for the Housing Society and my last 7 years were spent as the Chief Executive Officer where we owned and operated approximately 400 units throughout Mission, Abbotsford, Chilliwack and Hope.

Turf Farm Proposal – 208th and Allard Crescent



Background

Katzie received a request to consult on a proposed turf farm at 20598 Allard Crescent, directly beside Katzie 2, as shown in the map below. We completed an initial review of the proposal, and have requested more information from the Proponent. We will host a knowledge sharing event with community when we learn more about the proposal and want to also share what we know now.

The Proposal

The proposal is to remove up to 2 m of peat bog from the site, and replace this with structural sand fill to support a turf farm (aqua blue-green area of map), build agricultural buildings (green area of map), have 15m stream setback (red cross hatch lines on map) from Yorkson creek to the west, and a tributary to Yorkson Creek to the south. The land is to be graded to drain to the north east corner at 208th and Allard Crescent, where a stormwater pond will be built on the property. This pond will connect to the drainage ditch along 208th, which flows into Yorkson creek.

Turf Farm Proposal – 208th and Allard Crescent

Request for Information

Katzie has requested additional information, to better understand if or how works could impact Katzie 2 or Yorkson Creek, and how the Proponent proposes to avoid these impacts if present, including:

- How will the removal of trees, shrubs, and peat soil in the turf farm area, that is to be replaced with sand-structural fill, impact site drainage, and runoff?
- How high will the land be built up to support turf farm operations, and how will this impact site drainage and runoff?
- How will this change flood risks to Katzie 2, and assurance that this is adequately assessed.

cáxcəǰəm (Mouth of Yorkson Creek) is a place of great significance and is part of Katzie's eco-cultural landscape. We will need to consider as part of our review the environmental and cultural heritage risks associated with this work and if or how this can be addressed. We hope to learn more about this from community in our upcoming knowledge sharing event.

Next Steps

When hear back about the site drainage and flood risk information we have requested, we will host an knowledge sharing event, to learn from community concerns, questions, and input to bring forward in this process.

The property is being routinely cleared of garbage that gets dumped there, but no development work for the turf farm is permitted to proceed. The Township of Langley requires a letter of support from Katzie before they will issue a soil fill permit, and we have notified them that our review is ongoing.

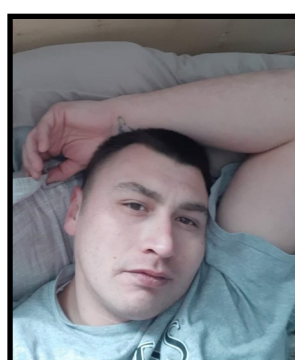
