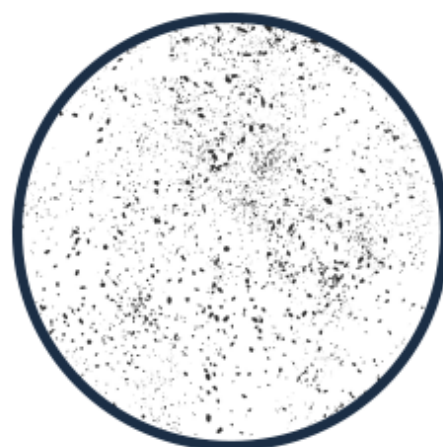

Why the Census Matters

Census information helps support planning and funding for services such as:

- Health Care

- Transportation & Infrastructure
- Community Programs

Identifying Census Staff

All Census staff carry:

- Official Statistics Canada photo identification
- Employee number
- Statistics Canada branded black lanyard

Current Enumerator assigned to Katzie 1, Katzie 2, and Katzie 3

Census staff will introduce themselves and show their identification upon request.

Participation is Required by Law

The Census is conducted under the Statistics Act

All households in Canada are required to complete the Census questionnaire

Failure to complete the Census may result in follow-up contact from Statistics Canada and could lead to penalties and a fine under Statistics Act
